

Hygiene Policy

GET Compliance is committed to ensuring hygiene is a priority in our day to day practices and in light of the recent Covid-19 outbreak.

Our aim with this policy is to prevent the spread of any and all infections if present and that the following good practices are observed.

FOR YOUR SAFETY

Preparation of our CPR Manikin Masks

- When handling the CPR Manikin Masks, staff are to wear food grade rubber gloves at all times.
- Used masks are washed in soapy hot water after every single use.
- Once washed, they are then sanitised with Chlorhexidine in Alcohol both front and back.
- Upon being dry, they are then placed immediately into a plastic bag and sealed.

Storage of used CPR Manikin Masks and Face Shields

- Once a trainee is finished with their single use face shield, they are required to put the face shield immediately into the rubbish.
- Upon the completion of the booked training, the CPR Manikin Mask is then placed into a sealed bucket by the Trainer. In the event a trainee wishes to have this mask replaced prior to the commencement of their CPR training, please ask the Trainer as they will accommodate this request.

Undertaking of CPR Training

In the light of the recent Covid-19 outbreak, our policy stands that no participant is required to use the Manikin for administration of breaths. The participant will be asked to verbalise the action until further notice.

FOR OUR SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF OUR STAFF AND STUDENTS

Please refrain from attending any training sessions:

- If you have come into contact with someone who has been diagnosed with or is currently in quarantine awaiting diagnosis of Covid-19;
- If you feel unwell in any way shape or form, including but not limited to flu-like symptoms such as coughing, sneezing, runny nose, sore throat and fatigue, unless you have a letter of clearance from a medical professional;
- If you are currently required to be under quarantine yourself.

If our Trainers observe any symptoms that may be concerning, you will be asked to leave and we will reschedule your training after 14 days.

Please ensure that you as an individual undertake all the necessary daily hygiene requirements to assist in the prevention of further spreading of Covid-19.

Monitoring of Policy

This policy will be reviewed annually or when required and changes may be implemented during the course of the year should government policies or guidelines change or our practices are reviewed.
